Quick Reference Guide



The Basics

Before your call: No reservations are needed. Distribute the <u>Dial-in Number</u> and <u>Conference ID</u>, along with the time of the call.

A Host is not required, unless you change the <u>Conference Start</u> setting via the Host Control Panel. To join as a Host, press star (*) instead of pound (#) after you enter the Conference ID — you will then be prompted to enter the <u>Host PIN</u>. If you wish to promote yourself to a Host during a conference in order to use the Host Keypad Commands, press star-three (*3), and you will be prompted to enter the Host PIN.

Host Control Panel

This online dashboard allows you to modify your conference line settings, monitor a live conference call, view activity reports and download records. The panel can be accessed at:

You will need your <u>Conference ID</u> and <u>Host PIN</u> to log into the panel. You do not need to use the panel during your conference calls, but the panel displays a list of participants, allowing you to mute and drop callers. After your conference, you can download recordings (if available) and print a list of participants.

Joining Your Conference Calls

Participants who call the Dial-in Number will be prompted to enter your <u>Conference ID</u> to join the conference. (Only hosts need to enter the <u>Host PIN</u>.)

Starting Your Conference

The <u>Conference Start</u> default determines whether the presence of a <u>Host</u> is required before the conference begins. If you want callers to stay on music-on-hold until the first <u>Host</u> arrives, change the <u>Conference Start</u> setting to "When Host Joins". If you want the conference to begin immediately, choose "When 2nd Caller Joins".

Conference Modes

For large conferences, you can use the <u>Conference Mode</u> setting to automatically mute participants, allowing one or more <u>Hosts</u> to speak while eliminating background noise. You can change the mode during conferences via the Host Control Panel or a Host Keypad Command.

Keypad Commands

As a Host, you can modify active settings using your phone keypad. Commands **in bold** are also available to non-Hosts.

Conference Mode	Description
Conversation *42	All un-muted.
Presentation * 41	Only Hosts can speak. Others muted.
Question & Answer *43	Non-Hosts muted, but can un-mute by pressing *6.
Hosts Only * 44	Private host conversation. Others placed on hold.
